The 8th Grade Leadership Team is a big part of our Spiritual Growth process at Emerge Middle School Ministry. We believe that we should Expose Jesus to middle school students at our Wednesday Night Emerge Worship Service, Equip them to follow Jesus in our small groups (Sunday Morning Small Groups), and help them to Experience life serving Jesus at E-Teams. What is the purpose of E-Core?

1. As the core of our student ministry, E-Core students are challenged to raise their personal walk with God, to be contributors in middle school ministry and be prepared for their High School transition.

Areas for E-Core students to contribute”

Emerge worship: prayer time, focus on God during worship, relationship building with new and regular attenders, help with set up and clean up

Small Groups: be a contributor in class, be an example in spiritual disciplines.

E-Teams: participate and be a contributor in weekly service.

Leadership: complete reading assignments, participate in class, work towards unity within the leadership team, be a contributor in ministry environments (lead a Bible study, be available for testimonies during large group time at Emerge, Small Groups, and/or E-Teams, blog, etc.), participate in E-Core Month, Mission Trip, Escape Trip.

How will we accomplish our purpose?

1. Work through a spiritual growth curriculum with an emphasis on leadership.
2. Apply real life leadership lessons.
3. Complete a team building exercise specific to current lesson learned.
