15-Aug	1) John 1:12 – Yet to all who received him, to those who believed in his name, he gave the right to become children of God.
22-Aug	2) John 3:3 - In reply Jesus declared, “I tell you the truth, no one can see the kingdom of God unless he is born again.”
29-Aug	3) I John 5:13 - I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life.
5-Sep	4) John 3:16 – For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life.
12-Sep	5) John 3:18 - Whoever believes in him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because he has not believed in the name of God’s one and only Son.
19-Sep	6) Psalms 126:5-6 - Those who sow in tears will reap with songs of joy. He who goes out weeping, carrying seed to sow, will return with songs of joy, carrying sheaves with him.

24-Oct	11) Matthew 9:37-38 - Then he said to his disciples, “The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field.”
31-Oct	12) Matthew 28:18-20 - Then Jesus came to them and said, “All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age.”
7-Nov	13) Luke 9:23 - Then he said to them all: “If anyone would come after me, he must deny himself and take up his cross daily and follow me.”
14-Nov	14) I John 1:9 - If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness.
21-Nov	15) John 1:1, 14 - In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God...The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the One and Only, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.
28-Nov	16) John 10:10 - The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life, and have it to the full.
5-Dec	17) Revelation 3:20 - Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with him, and he with me.
12-Dec	18) John 14:6 - Jesus answered, “I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me.”
19-Dec	19) Acts 1:8 - But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

2-Jan	20) Acts 4:12 - Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved.
9-Jan	21) Romans 5:8 - But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.
16-Jan	22) Romans 6:23 - For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.
23-Jan	23) Romans 10:9-10 - That if you confess with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved.
30-Jan	24) 2 Timothy 1:12 - That is why I am suffering as I am. Yet I am not ashamed, because I know whom I have believed, and am convinced that he is able to guard what I have entrusted to him for that day.
6-Feb	25) Romans 10:13 for, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."
13-Feb	26) Romans 10:17 - Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word of Christ.
20-Feb	27) 2 Corinthians 6:2 - For he says, "In the time of my favor I heard you, and in the day of salvation I helped you." I tell you, now is the time of God's favor, now is the day of salvation.
27-Feb	28) Ephesians 2:8-9 – For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith -- and this not from yourselves, it is the gift of God – not by works, so that no one can boast.
6-Mar	29) John 5:24 – "I tell you the truth, whoever hears my word and believes him who sent me has eternal life and will not be condemned; he has crossed over from death to life.
13-Mar	30) Hebrews 2:3 - ...how shall we escape if we ignore such a great salvation? This salvation, which was first announced by the Lord, was confirmed to us by those who heard him.
20-Mar	31) Hebrews 9:22 - In fact, the law requires that nearly everything be cleansed with blood, and without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness.
27-Mar	32) Acts 4:31 - After they prayed, the place where they were meeting was shaken. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God boldly.
3-Apr	33) Hebrews 9:27 - Just as man is destined to die once, and after that to face judgment...
10-Apr	34) Hebrews 10:25 - Let us not give up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but let us encourage one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.
17-Apr	35) James 2:19 - You believe that there is one God. Good! Even the demons believe that—and shudder.

29-May	40) Isaiah 53:5 - But he was pierced for our transgressions, he was crushed for our iniquities; the punishment that brought us peace was upon him, and by his wounds we are healed.

5-Jun	41) 2 Corinthians 3:18 – And we, who with unveiled faces all reflect the Lord's glory, are being transformed into his likeness with ever-increasing glory, which comes from the Lord, who is the Spirit.
12-Jun	42) Ephesians 3: 17b-19 – And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the saints, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God.
19-Jun	43) Isaiah 41:10 – So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand.
26-Jun	44) Lamentations 3:22-23 – Because of the Lord's great love we are not consumed, for his compassions never fail. They are new every morning; great is your faithfulness.
3-Jul	45) 1 Peter 3:15 – But in your hearts set apart Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that you have. But do this with gentleness and respect.
10-Jul	46) Romans 12:5 – So in Christ we who are many form one body, and each member belongs to all the others.
17-Jul	47) John 15:5 – I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man remains in me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from me you can do nothing.
