The Upperclassmen Leadership Team is a crucial part of our discipleship process at the FBCO High School Ministry. We believe that we should EXPOSE High School students to a relationship with Jesus at our Wednesday night Worship Service, EQUIP them to follow Jesus in our small groups (Sunday Morning Small Groups) and provide them a platform to EXPERIENCE a life serving Jesus at e-Teams. You will be expected to be a contributor at each ministry environment, so it is important for you to be actively involved in all 3, weekly.

Please consider the following commitments as you pray about this opportunity:

- Actively involved at Elevate worship service (Wed. 6-8:30pm)
- Actively involved in Sunday morning Small Groups (Sunday 8:10am or 9:30am)
- Actively involved in UNITY guys/girls groups (Sunday 4-6pm)
- Attend the 2 times a month leadership meeting (Bible Study, Leadership Training, Team Building) (Sun. 6-7:30pm...dinner included)
- Opportunity to lead a student Bible study (Seniors leading sophomores, Juniors leading freshmen) (Sun. 6-7:30pm 2 times a month or Sundays 4-6pm)
- Lead by example in behavior, attitude, and respect for others.

Junior/Freshmen Bible Study

What is the purpose of ELEVATE Leadership?

- 1. To challenge students to personally ELEVATE their walk with God, in relation to begin a leader for His cause.**
- 2. To challenge students to ELEVATE the ministry environments that they are involved in.**

ELEVATE worship: prayer time, focus on God during worship, relationship building with new and regular attenders, help with set up and clean up

Small Groups: be a contributor in class, be an example in spiritual disciplines.

eTeams: participate and be a contributor in weekly service.

Leadership: complete reading assignments, participate in class, work towards unity within the leadership team, Senior to Junior passing of the torch, be a contributor in ministry environments (lead a Bible study, be available for testimonies during large group time at ELEVATE, BFGs, and/or eTeams, blog, etc.), participate in Leadership Month...May...(ELEVATE service, teach BFGs)
